1. **Cordaid Zimbabwe**, as Project Implementation Entity on behalf of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Zimbabwe, will be implementing a Grant from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development/International Development Association toward the cost of **Zimbabwe National Results Based Financing Programme**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Grant to payments under the Contract for the supply of Nine (9) units 4 WD SUV vehicles, RHD as detailed in the Technical Specifications, IFB No.: CORZWO01
2. **Cordaid, Zimbabwe** now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for supply of Nine (9) units 4 WD SUV vehicles, RHD as detailed in the Technical Specifications, IFB No.: CORZWO01.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, January 2011 and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Guidelines.

6. Qualifications requirements include:
 - (a) Financial Capability
The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s):
 - (I) Average turnover for the last three (3) years should be equivalent to three times the total value of the bid under consideration.”
 - (II) Audited Accounts/financial statements for the last three years demonstrating the soundness of the bidder.”
 - (b) Experience and Technical Capacity
The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):

The bidder should have executed at least two (2) contracts of similar nature and complexity within the last three (3) years. In doing so, the bidder will be expected to indicate the name of the contract, values and name of purchaser.
 - (c) The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that the Goods it offers meet the following usage requirement:
 - Statement from the manufacturer confirming that the vehicles offered are suitable to withstand the climatologically and road conditions within the Republic of Zimbabwe



- A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically “**shall not**” be applied.
7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in **English** may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee of 100 US Dollars. For USD transfers remittance should be made through the same bank as mentioned above. The document will be sent by electronic means after receipt of payment for the bidding documents by Cordaid.
 8. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Friday 10 February 2012 at 1.00 p.m.** Electronic bidding will **not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend in person or on-line at the address below at **Friday 10 February 2012 at 1.30 p.m.** All bids must be accompanied by a “**Bid Security**” of **10.000 US Dollars**
